About our Calendar of Events

Forth Valley Disability Sport – Regional events

FVDS organise both junior and senior events across Forth Valley. For junior events, the local events will often act as qualifiers to the regional event. The decision on who qualifies will be made by the organisers of the local events.

Senior events are often open to participants from other branches. This is to provide a healthier level of competition, and increase opportunities for adults across Scotland.

Scottish Disability Sport – National events

Entry to National events is usually via the FVDS branch, with the regional events acting as qualifiers.
